

The National College Match is a college admission and scholarship process through which high-achieving students can be admitted early with full four-year scholarships to QuestBridge college partners.

College partners at QuestBridge include some of the most selective institutions of higher education around the world, including schools such as Princeton University, MIT, Stanford University, and others.

The Indiana Academy Class of 2023 included three QuestBridge scholars, matched to the Universitty of Chicago, Washington & Lee University, and Northwestern University.


