

SAT/ACT WAIVERS FOR NATIONAL TESTS

Eligibility

- Those students who qualify for financial aid or free textbooks are eligible for free SAT and ACT testing waivers.

What the waivers cover

- Each SAT waiver covers the registration fees for a single test date, either for the SAT or for up to three SAT Subject Tests. Each ACT waiver covers the basic registration fee for either the ACT (No Writing) or the ACT Plus Writing.
- For the SAT a total of four additional flexible score reports can be ordered any time after you register, even after you've seen your scores.
- For the ACT, this fee covers up to four college choices.
- SAT Waivers cover either the [Question-and-Answer Service or the Student Answer Service](#) (for the SAT only) when ordered during registration.

Where to obtain a waiver

- Obtain your waiver through the College and Career Counseling Office (CCCC, Wagoner Hall, room 170). Fee waivers are not available through the College Board.

How many?

- Four total waivers are available — two for the SAT and two for the SAT Subject Tests. SAT Subject Test fee waivers can be used any time from 9th grade through graduation. SAT fee waivers can be used from 11th grade through graduation.
- Two total waivers are available for the ACT.

COLLEGE BOARD ADMISSION FEE WAIVERS

Eligibility

- You are eligible if you used SAT or SAT Subject Tests fee waivers and plan to enter college in the fall of 2011.

How the waivers work

- The Request for Waiver of College Application Fee forms notify participating colleges that you have participated in the SAT Program Fee-Waiver Service and request that they consider waiving their application fees.

Where to obtain a waiver

- Obtain your waiver through the College and Career Counseling Office (CCCC, Wagoner Hall, room 170) when submitting your College Application Request Form. Admission waivers are not available through the College Board.
- Download the [Directory of Colleges Cooperating with the SAT Program Fee-Waiver Service](#) document and check to make sure the colleges to which you're applying will accept it.

How many can you receive

- You are eligible to receive up to four Request for Waiver of College Application Fee forms.

NACAC ADMISSIONS FEE WAIVERS

Eligibility

- Those students who qualify for financial aid or free textbooks are eligible for free SAT and ACT testing waivers.

How the waivers work

- Students can use these waivers for the purpose of waiving the admissions fees.
- Obtain your NACAC waiver through the College and Career Counseling Office (CCCC, Wagoner Hall, room 170) when submitting your College Application Request Form.

How many can you receive

- The number of waivers provided will be at the discretion of the CCCC Office.

TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY SCHOLARS

How it works

- If you are a participant in Twenty-first Century Scholar Program, all public and private **Indiana** colleges and universities will waive the application fee as a matter of policy.

Where to obtain a waiver

- Obtain your waiver through the College and Career Counseling Office (CCCC, Wagoner Hall, room 170) when submitting your College Application Request Form.
